The RJ-5 was designed by Harland Ross and Johnson. Ross started construction in California and Johnson finished it at Mississippi State College where he is an engineering student. Harland Ross is well known for his successful sailplane designs, most famous being the Zanonia flown by Johnnie Robinson.
