panel. A small block of steel is secured to the motor shaft as an eccentric weight, using a 6-32 Allen head set screw in a tapped hole.

Some pilots may prefer to add an additional switch in the circuit, possibly on the instrument panel itself, which will permit the vibrator to be operated for continuous periods during a climb without requiring the use of the switch added on the control column. Both will be found useful, as a rule.

The sources of the necessary items:

(1) The tiny electric motor, from any hobby or model supply shop—the one used was an Aristo-Craft no. 1.5, \$1.35.

(2) The surplus control grip with built-in switches, NAF-49110-2 or equivalent, order no. A-1068, from Karl Ort, York, Pennsylvania, \$1.97 post paid.
