## FAI AWARDS

Applications for FAI Soaring Awards should be mailed to SSA, Box 66071, Los Angeles 66, Calif. The envelope must bear a postmark date less than six months from the time of the flight or the application will not be honored. This eliminates discrepancies at the time badges are completed and insures the correct assignment of numbers. Approved legs are kept in a pending file by SSA until badge requirements are completed.

## NOTE

Distance and duration legs applications not accompanied by a barogram should have added a statement by an SSA Official Observer that the flight was under his continual observation.

## INTERVALS BETWEEN WORLD CONTESTS CHANGED AGAIN

Dr. A. E. Slater reported in "The Aeroplane" for February 12th that the FAI had reversed their previous decision to hold World Soaring Championships every three years instead of two after 1960. In the future they will be held every two years as before.
