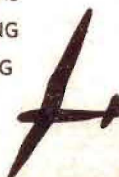

MORE RECORDS SURPASSED

According to notices received from
F.A.I., three more world soaring re-
cords have recently been surpassed.
All are subject to later formal ap-
proval before becoming official.

On July 13th, Victor Ilchenko of
Russia flew a two-place A-10 sail-
plane around a 100 km. triangle at
56.54 mph. This exceeds the current
open record of 54.377 mph set by
Harland Ross of the U.S. in his R-6
sailplane in 1958.

On July 14th, Palagia Majewska
of Poland flew a single-place Foka
sailplane around a 300 km. triangle
at 38.53 mph. Another Pole, Lucyna
Bajewska holds the current feminine
record of 31.088 mph.

On July 15th, Anna Samosadova
of Russia flew a single-place, 200
km. triangle at 43.49 mph, exceed-
ing the current feminine record of
37.231 mph held by Wanda Szem-
plinska of Poland.
