1960 RUSSIAN CHAMPION

Victor Goncharenko, opera singer with the Kiev Opera Company, and contestant in the 1958 Internationals in Leszno, Poland, won the 1960 U.S.S.R. Soaring Championship.

After winning the 1960 Ukrainian National Competitions, Victor, as a member of the Ukrainian team, participated in the United Competitions of the U.S.S.R. The weather permitted only three days of flying, in which he placed fourth, second, and second, for the highest total score and the Championship.

Victor was flying the Blanik A-15 all-metal sailplane, which is claimed to have 40/1 glide ratio, and will soon be in quantity production. Serious attempts will be made on the international distance records by a number of pilots in A-15's in 1961.

Victor reports that the U.S. film "Oklahoma" was shown in Kiev, and he watched, with admiration, the cumulus clouds over Oklahoma, and concluded the U.S.A. had among the best soaring conditions of all.

A new book, entitled "The Story of the Sport of Soaring" is being written by Victor, when time permits from his concert tours.
