CHANGES IN MARKING REGULATIONS

New regulations for the marking of U.S. civil registrations on aircraft became effective on January 1, 1962. All registrations applied after that date must be in figures at least 12 inches high and on each side of the fuselage or other vertical surface. Those aircraft presently carrying registrations on the wings and tail can leave them there until repaint/recover or January 1, 1966, whichever comes sooner. The last changes in registration application were deletion of the second letter (NC, NX, etc.), in 1948 and the optional application of registration to each side of the fuselage in 1951.
