Bacon, will be on hand to fly checkout rides and to render whatever other assistance is found to be necessary.

The Soaring Corporation hopes that individual pilots and clubs will come to Harris Hill this summer to attempt their distance flights for Silver, Gold, and Diamond Badges. The organization will attempt to give pilots all the services necessary for these flights; i.e., checkouts, tow plane on site, on-site cabins, weather briefings at County Airport, winch tows and many other services. There is a possibility that limited retrieve crews may be available if requests for such are made in advance.
