Basic specifications for the ship are as follows: span, 49.3 ft.; wing area, 126 sq. ft.; aspect ratio, 19.0; empty wt., 337 lb.; gross wt., 583 lb.; wing loading, 4.6 lb./sq.ft.; glide ratio, 29 at 45 mph; sinking speed, 2.1 ft./sec. at 40 mph. An Exacta camera with 100 mm telephoto lens, exposing Kodak Plus-X film at 1/500—5.6, was used to obtain this photo by Eugene G. Bartos.
