

SSA LIFE MEMBERSHIP CONTEST RULES AND PRIZES

Over \$1000 worth of prizes! Become an SSA Life Member to be eligible to win one of the valuable prizes in this contest.

Life Membership in SSA costs \$200, which may be paid in four consecutive quarterly installments of \$50 each. Present SSA members desiring to upgrade to this status receive credit for the unearned portion of their existing dues.
