## Observer Requirement

Attention is called to the provision that any SSA voting member or Student Member who has earned a leg of an FAI soaring badge is qualified to act as an SSA Official Observer in the supervision of flights for badges by others. This was provided for when the ABC Training Program went into effect, after which the C badge (the previous Observer requirement) could be issued only by SSA Instructors.

## Correction to "FAI Soaring Awards and Procedures" Article in Last Issue

A significant error was discovered in the above-titled article after it was printed in the February issue of *Soaring*. On page 11, paragraph 8.2.1 (c), the figures should be 1,000 metres and 3,281 ft., respectively, not 3,000 metres and 9,842 ft. It is suggested that all readers correct these figures in their copy of the February issue since this is a basic reference article that will be in effect for some time to come.
