Nationals Notes

The time is at hand for all good soaring pilots to complete their applications for the '64 nationals. We appreciate your problems in arranging to attend the nationals and assume you appreciate ours as hosts.

We of the Nebraska Soaring Assn., Inc., are preparing a brochure which will require a good photo of each competing pilot (and sailplane) as well as an educational, vocational, family and flying history. Please send plenty of biographical material. We want our contest champion (it may be you) adequately represented. Please signify your intention to compete and send photos with biographical material to NSA, Box 491, McCook Nebraska 69001.

RULES

Rules for the 1964 contest will be essentially the same as those used last year. Modifications include the following: it will not be necessary to land after completing a speed task before attempting it again; penalty distance for off-course landings is redefined by ro-

tating landing point onto course line from next turn point rather than subtracting perpendicular distance away from course line; and standby applications are provided for up through the day before the contest begins.

Pilots intending to compete at McCook may receive an advance copy of the rules by requesting same in writing to SSA.

ENTRIES

Concerning entries, the rules specify a deadline for preferential applications of April 30th. After that, applications will be accepted in order of date of postmark from anyone who holds the Gold badge distance leg, up through June 29th. All entries must be made on official blanks requested from the sponsor (Nebraska Soaring Assn., Box 491, McCook, Neb. 69001) and accompanied by \$25 (one-half of the entry fee). The sponsors do not expect to limit the number of entries; however they *may* not be able to accept any after June 16th, after which those received will be considered standby ones *if* towing facilities are limited.
