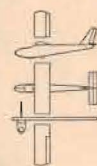

line at 2:05 and their struggles were witnessed to and from Silver Springs. Delafield landed short of the turn. A number made the second turn and beyond—Leffler to within seven miles of home base. Carl Herold made it around at 33.8 mph. Bob Klemmedson struggled deeper into the Sierras than anyone else dared but finally made the whole triangle at 6:23 for 19.8 mph and was by virtue of this flight and his other fine performances chosen the Sierra Soaring Champion for 1964 and awarded a silver wine cooler with silver tray. Second place winner was Carl Herold, flying a Ka-6CR; third, Allan Leffler; fourth, Richard Delafield in the 1-23 Standard. In addition, each contestant received a gold plaque. All awards were donated by the National Championship Air Races.



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
