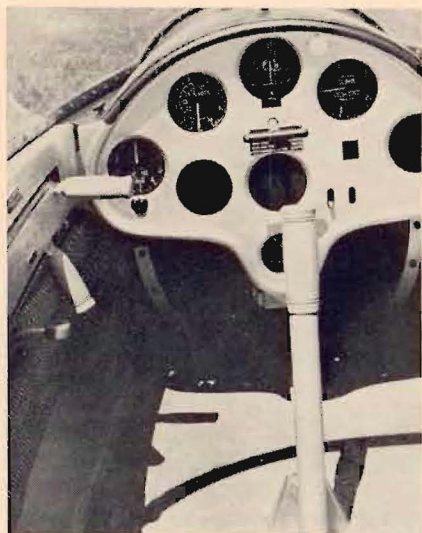

certain amount of spare parts such as tail skids, tire and tube, and a bridle for the side mounted c/g releases.

To summarize, the Blanik is an extremely pleasant ship to fly, with no bad habits, and a very good performance for its size. We evaluated many different two-seaters such as the Ka-7, Bergfalke, Boccian, Slingsby T-49 and Schweizer 2-32, before deciding that the Blanik would give us the best value for our money. So far we have had no cause to regret our choice.

#### NOTE!

Pilots trying for FAI awards on the same day and same or different flight may act as SSA Observers for each other; however, they may not act as each other's turn point observer nor landing observer.

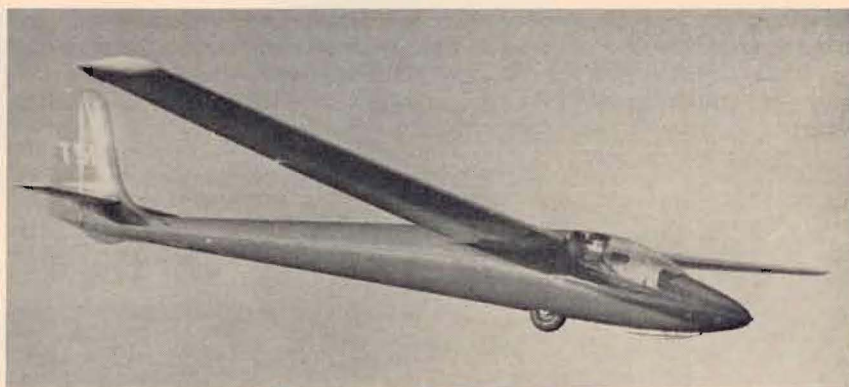
