Recent articles or items on soaring which have appeared in non-soaring publications.

**Air Facts**, May, 1966, pp. 39-43, 46-48. "Diamond High" by Marshall Claybourn. An exposition of wave flying, plus an example in the form of a flight by Marshall, in his 1-26, at the Black Forest Gliderport.

**Chicago, The Quarterly Magazine of Mid-America**, Summer, 1966, pp. 39-41. "Soaring with hawks and gulls" by Alex and Dita Aldott. Several hundred words of text and seven splendid color photographs by the Aldotts, constituting about the best pictorial coverage of soaring to appear in a mass-circulation magazine.

**Sport Aviation**, May, 1966, pp. 23-4. "The Primary Glider" by Weldon S. Hicks. Part one of a two-part article concerned with learning to glide the way they did it when dad was a youngster—solo from the beginning, on an open framework.

**Travel**, April, 1966, pp. 37-40. "Sky Sailing" by Virginia M. Black. A nicely presented introduction to gliding, including three photos taken at Calistoga Air Park, Calif.

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
