Soaring Mailing

A number of letters from readers indicate that some members receive their *Soarings* significantly later than other members in the same area. Such delays are in the postal system because all copies of each issue are mailed at exactly the same time. Some cities get preferential treatment after that because bulk mailings must be prepared in a special way. Cities with six or more magazines are bundled together and so labeled, such that they go directly to that city. Other cities are tied in miscellaneous state bundles and go to a central distribution point in the state for breakdown. Within a city bundle of six or more, differential delays would originate within that local post office. Magazines are classified as second class mail and individual mailmen are not obliged to deliver them the day they come in. If the delay is more than a few days a word to your local postmaster might help.
