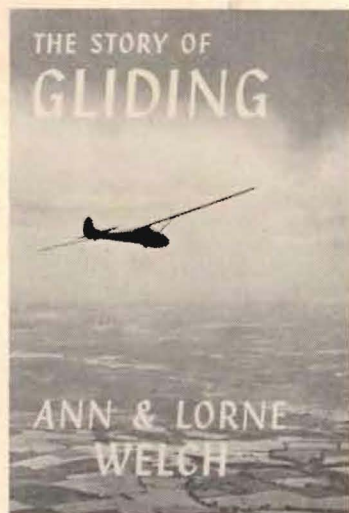

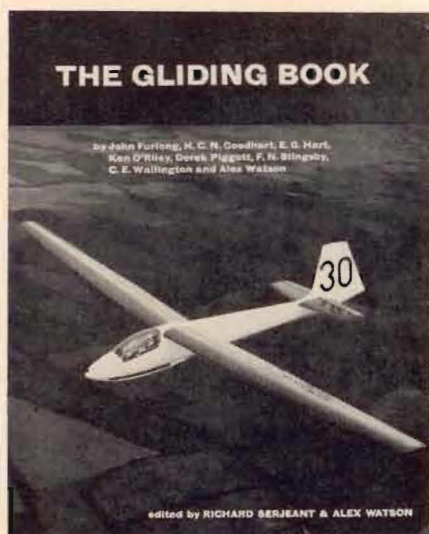
Presents Two New Books From England—

This most recent book from England, edited by Richard Serjeant and Alex Watson, contains good basic chapters on aerodynamics (*The Elements of Gliding Flight*) and meteorology (*The Ever-Changing Sky*, by C. E. Wallington) which make it very suitable for the young or beginning pilot. Later chapters, notably *Making Gliders*, by Fred Slingsby, and *Achievements*, by Nick Goodhart, are meat for pilots of any age or experience. Illustrated with 31 photographs and numerous diagrams, in larger-than-usual format.
