Mr. Harvey Doyle of Waynesboro, Virginia, has been appointed Schleicher dealer for the States of Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Connecticut, New York, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware, Maryland, Virginia, West Virginia, the Carolinas and Georgia.
