This new American-made, self-contained communications system is so small it'll fit in your pocket.

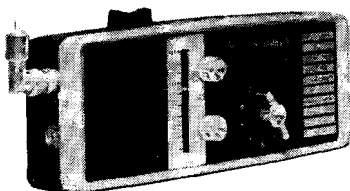
But don't let its size fool you.
