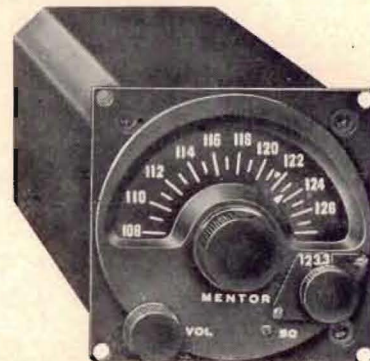
1967 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS?

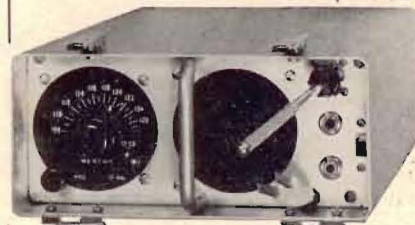
