SOARING'S NEW COVER DESIGN

This issue of *Soaring* marks the first appearance of our new cover format announced in the November issue. The last change in cover was in January 1959. The new design is part of a continuing program to update and improve the appearance of the magazine.

The design was an outgrowth of studies of how to make more effective use of color, including the eventual use of full-color photos on the cover. The clean lines and use of white space in the new design enhances the appearance of both black and white and color photos.

The flexibility of the three-way format has been enthusiastically welcomed by our photographers as well as those who must select cover photos and we hope *Soaring* readers will also like it. We will run through the three variations of photo size and arrangements during the next several months and would welcome comments on the different versions.
